Dear Academy for Urban Leadership Charter School Families,

I am so thrilled to be a part of this wonderful school. I know that we will have a very successful school year. As we prepare to welcome our students and staff back to campus for the start of the 2021-2022 school year, please be advised that AULCS will require all faculty, staff, students, and visitors to wear face coverings (mask) while inside the building beginning Monday, August 16, 2021, pursuant of Executive Order 251.

Executive Order 251 was signed by Governor Murphy on August 6, 2021 mandates that all public, private, and parochial preschool programs and elementary and secondary school, including charter and renaissance schools (collectively "school districts"), must maintain a policy regarding mandatory use of face masks by staff, students, and visitors in the indoor portion of the school district premises.

The Executive Order went into effect on Monday, August 9, 2021. The order aligns with Sterling High School's masking requirements for students, staff, and visitors, which have been in effect since the summer of 2020.
